



BOOSTING THE ECONOMY

The forestry industry is worth £2bn every year to the UK economy



SOAKING UP CARBON

Growing trees soak up carbon and lock that away in wood products



CREATING RURAL JOBS

Forestry supports 80,000 UK jobs, often in rural areas with few other employment opportunities



GOOD FOR FARMING

Forestry on sheep farms can increase returns from the land and help animal welfare



REDUCING FLOOD RISK

Upland tree planting can reduce flood risks in communities downstream



PLACES TO ROAM

Forests provide places for exercise and recreation, benefiting physical and mental health



HOMES FOR WILDLIFE

Forests are home for wildlife, such as Red squirrels, Goshawks and many other rare species
