Decisions need to be made quickly

The UK's goals for addressing climate climate are unlikely to be met without fundamental land reform. Proposed new UK laws on agriculture and the environment means there is now a one-off opportunity to define a new land strategy.

Nationally, action is required to do the following:

Reduction in grasslands and rough grazing by 2050 (up to) 1.5 million hectares



of new woodland to store carbon by 2050 (up to) 1.2 million hectares
